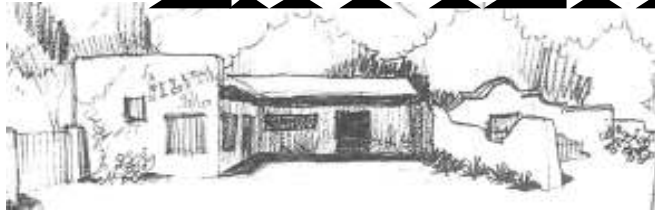

THE OLD ARIZONA BRASS BAND reenacts the 1884-1888 regimental band of Fort Lowell. In early Tucson, citizens enjoyed the music of bands in concerts and parades. That regimental band played for military and civilian affairs.

At La Pilita Museum on Feb 3rd their music will bring back the memories of bands that played in Elysian Grove and Carrillo Gardens in the late 1800's and early 1900's.
