As you face north at the corner of Meyer and Simpson, you can imagine the mule drawn trolley bringing citizens to Elysian Grove for a barbeque, a dog race, an air show, or a picnic in the park. On weekends that trolley would make the turn from Meyer onto the spur at Simpson and go 600 feet to deliver passengers to The Grove. Long buried track was excavated during a sewer renovation in 2006.
